

Foundation Announces Art Commissioning

The Stratford and Perth County Community Foundation has just announced that it will commission a piece of art to use on various printed materials and to complement the Foundation's logo. The artwork will be of an image, or a collage, of Perth County vista(s).

"While the project represents a significant test of creative thinking, as PerthCounty is a diverse area featuring an urban/rural dichotomy and six distinctive municipalities, we believe the local art community is up to the challenge," said Community Foundation Board Chair, Tim MacDonald. "We also think it will be a wonderful opportunity for a local artist to have their name associated with this piece and enjoy the potential benefits that may ensue."

The artwork is being commissioned as the Foundation's fifth anniversary project and will be unveiled at the Foundation's Gala event on January 15th, 2010.

The artwork can be created using any medium including oils, water colours, acrylics, photographs, sculptural form, or another appropriate medium. The ability to easily, and cost effectively, professionally reproduce the artwork is an important requirement. The selected original artwork, and all of its copyrights, will become the property of the Foundation. However the name and signature of the artist will be associated with the work. It is proposed that the honorarium for the completed work be \$1000.
